


#### We Have Better Bears than Saginaw


Sendera Ranch is a community nestled within the city of Fort Worth, spanning throughout Tarrant County and partly in Denton County.


Housed residents and bears in good standing with the HOA are allowed to visit Smokey Bear every other Tuesday.
